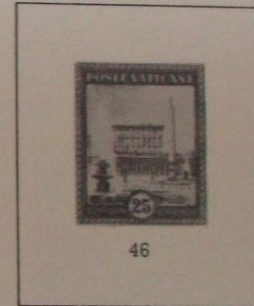

Apostolic Palace erected by Pope Symmachus, 5th century. Presently it comprises a group of buildings occupying 13½ acres and containing 20 courts, 1000 halls and chapels in which is found the Sistine Chapel (Michaelangelo's *Last Judgment*) and the world famous Vatican Library. Obelisk of Tuthmosis III, capped by a bronze cross containing a fragment of True Cross. Obelisk was brought to Rome from Egypt by Caligula in 1st century A.D.

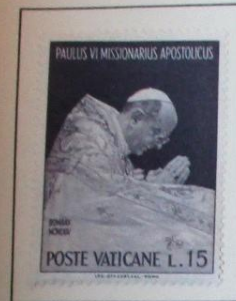

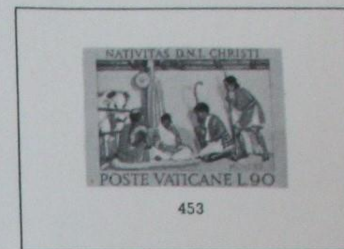
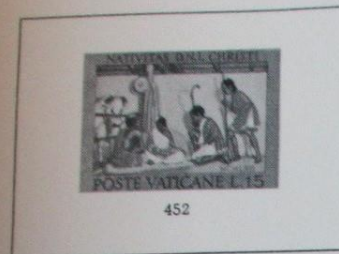
