




Apostolic Palace erected by Pope Symmachus, 5th century. Presently it comprises a group of buildings occupying 13½ acres and containing 20 courts, 1000 halls and chapels in which is found the Sistine Chapel (Michaelangelo's Last Judgment) and the world famous Vatican Library. Obelisk of Tuthmosis III, capped by a bronze cross containing a fragment of True Cross. Obelisk was brought to Rome from Egypt by Caligula in 1st century A.D.


