SCV over \$950, few faults but generally clean and sound. (Est \$120-150) **65**
- 354 Sierra Leone Collection in Binder** - A well filled 1" binder holding over 450 stamps mounted on Steiner computer generated pages (pages not complete). Coverage is from 1893-1986 with a few better sets amongst the many others, and 12 first days, which include the Face of Mars set on FDC. SCV over \$900 plus some unprocessed material inside the back pocket. Some faults but generally clean and sound. (Est \$120-150) **65**
- 355 Singapore Collection in 2 Binders** - Collection of over 500 items, 1948-1999 on Steiner computer generated pages (pages not complete). - 358 Spain Collection in 12 Binders** - 12 x 1" binders loaded with 2600+ stamps, souv sheets, booklets, first days and postcards (around 400), and more, 1850s-1998, all mounted to Steiner computer generated (pages not complete). Sparse in the classics but picks up in the 1950s-60s, then fairly comprehensive unused with much MNH in the many affordable sets during this period. A small envelope of unprocessed material follows. - 367 Syria Scott C1, C3 on Cover, Early Usage** - Early use of French stamps for the purpose of airmail during French occupation. SCV \$240 for stamps on cover. Vertical fold not affecting stamps, some toning. Please inspect. (Est \$60-80) **36**
- 368 Tanzania Collection in 3 Binders** - Accumulation of mostly unused sets and souvenir sheets, 1964-1992, with some MNH on Steiner computer generated pages (pages not complete). Lots of topical content in well over 500 items. The best is a set of 10 John Paul sheets of 10 (Scott 825-34, SCV \$175). Some first days, sheetlets, and some collateral material included. SCV just over \$1000. Generally fine or better. (Est \$200-250) **90**
- 369 Thailand Collection in 5 Binders** - 5 x 1" binders holding over 1500 stamps/souvenir sheets mounted on Steiner computer generated pages (pages not complete). Better unused include Scott 1-5, 89, C15-19 and souvenir sheets Scott 632a, 748a, 756a, 992a, 1001a, 1117a and used Scott 122, 155-6, 243-54. Continues to the 2000s with some affordable sets and some postally used. Many nice examples throughout along with a few booklets and first day covers. Good candidate to fill holes in your collection. SCV around \$4000. Viewing recommended. Some mixed condition early on, then generally fine or better. (Est \$600-800) **325**
- 370 Togo Collection in 8 Binders to 2000** - The first binder is a 1915-69 collection of 350 stamps on Minkus pages with good representation of Gold Coast (British) and Dahomey (French) overprinted issues. The remaining binders hold about 1300 mostly unused stamps and souvenir sheets mounted on Steiner computer generated pages (pages not complete). - 375 Venezuela Collection in 4 Binders** - 4 x 1" binders loaded with over 1800 stamps/souvenir sheets mounted on Steiner computer generated pages (pages not complete). Earlies which hold some good value are typically used or MNG. Most of the Arms issue of the 1950s are present in either used or mint. Continues to the 1980s with a few later and unprocessed at the back. Good candidate to fill holes in your collection. SCV around \$7500. Viewing recommended and should be advantageous. Some mixed condition early on, then generally fine or better. (Est \$900-1200) **500**
- 376 Virgin Islands - Two Collection Lot** - A pair of collections.... The first mounted/hinged on computer generated Steiner pages 1860s-1975 (pages not complete), and the other in two binders holding Minkus pages 1960s-1990s with little mounted and a bunch loose between pages ready for mounting. We spotted unused Scott 2, 3, 4, 6, 7a, 18, 21-8, 38-46, 49-52, 115-27, and used 8, 10, 11 (thin), 12, and much more. SCV around \$3300. - 392 Worldwide Mish-Mash in 2 Large Boxes** - Lots of diverse philatelic material: Albums from Czech, modern Canada (lots of face value), Globe Stamp Album, Modern Stamp Album, a couple Acme Stamp stockbooks, etc. Also Fleetwood US FDCs, souvenir collections, Cayman Island brochures, US joint issues, Netherlands and Canada year sets, and so much more. Very mixed condition. (Est \$300-400) **150**
- 393 Foreign Accumulation in a Pizza Box** - Mostly foreign unused singles, sets, souvenir sheets, and a few Greenland year sets over-populate a pizza type box.
